

Several Granville Township residents requested the trustees explore the possibility of a contract similar to the recently implemented St. Albans Township contract with a single trash collection company. The benefits would be to reduce rates, minimize the number of trucks on roadways, create safer driving conditions and provide quality services throughout the Township. The Granville Township Trustees put out a community survey and held a public meeting to obtain resident input. Big O, Rumpke and Waste Management submitted proposals based upon township-developed specifications. The Trustees plan to discuss the single trash hauler proposal and perhaps reach a decision at their next meeting on February 11, 2009.

- 1) Senior Citizen Discount to households where one member is 65 or older.
- 2) A variable operating cost for haulers is fuel. Haulers were offered the opportunity to submit an alternate proposal which included a base price and an indexed method of determining a fuel surcharge to be added to the bill.
  - a) Big O submitted fixed price only with no alternate variable fuel surcharge pricing.
  - b) Rumpke submitted a fixed price with certain qualifications. It also submitted an alternate bid under which its fuel surcharge is indexed to highway diesel fuel prices listed by the Energy Information Administration of the U.S. Department of Energy (EIA/DOE), along with certain qualifications.
  - c) Waste Management did not submit a fixed price but did submit an alternate bid with a fuel surcharge indexed to the EIA/DOE highway diesel price list and put certain qualifications on its recycling services.

The township trustees are seeking additional information from the residents of the unincorporated portion of the township to assist the trustees in evaluating the hauler proposals that were received. The trustees would like to obtain a representative sample of the various residential trash bills that are presently being paid by the residents. For
